RE: CenturyLink's Comments - Proposed Rule Amendment R746-360

Dear Mr. Widerburg:

On May 14, 2015, the Utah Public Service Commission (PSC) sent out email notice of its proposed amendments to rule R746-360 Universal Public Telecommunications Service Support Fund. In the notice it provided the opportunity for interested parties to file comments by no later than July 1, 2015.

Based upon a review of the proposed changes, it appears that the PSC is only interested at this time to consider limited rule changes to make the rule consistent with recommendations in a recent audit.¹ CenturyLink does not have any comments regarding the PSC's proposed changes.

If at some time in the future the PSC determines to expand this rulemaking to include consideration of other proposed changes to rule R746-360, CenturyLink most likely will provide comments and recommendations.
