PacifiCorp dba Rocky Mountain Power (“Rocky Mountain Power” or “the Company”) hereby submits its comments in the above referenced Notice of Proposed Rule Amendment.

The Company supports the Commission’s initiative to consider efficiencies to simplify filing and service requirements. The Company believes the elimination of the requirement for paper copies of pleadings will result in a more streamlined and efficient filing process.

In support of the Commission’s initiative, the Company provides herein proposed edits to R746-100-3 and R746-100-4 to eliminate the requirement for filing paper copies of non-confidential and confidential pleadings. The Company edits also provide for the potential establishment of a secure website that may be used for filing of confidential and non-confidential pleadings. The Company respectfully requests that the Commission schedule a workshop for interested parties to discuss how a website might be used for filing of confidential and non-confidential materials in proceedings, including discovery.
