NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO FILE
CONCERNS AND QUESTIONS
REGARDING AVAILABLE
PROTOCOL FOR PAPERLESS FILING

ISSUED: October 14, 2016

At the October 11, 2016 technical conference in these dockets, several utilities raised concerns and questions about filing confidential and highly confidential information with the Commission via a Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP), using a secure channel through a state web portal, with no passwords or file data transferred, and with the data encrypted to the SFTP server to prevent unauthorized access. After being received by the Commission, documents containing confidential and highly confidential information would be stored on secure state servers in the same manner in which those documents, currently being provided to the Commission through email or physical media, are presently stored.

The Commission wishes to ensure that, if the SFTP is created, it will be used for confidential and highly confidential information as well as for public information. Therefore, any utility that has questions or concerns about the proposed system may file those questions and concerns in these dockets no later than **Tuesday, October 25, 2016**. After reviewing the filings, the Commission will issue additional information regarding the adoption of a paperless filing system.
